<u>Time Required:</u> 5-15 minutes


<u>Description</u>: Student will review the Illinois State Symbols by matching pairs of cards containing pictures of the Symbols.

Materials Needed:


- 1) One State Symbols Matching Game page for each pair of students.

Directions:


- 1) Cut out the pictures of each symbol.
- 2) Turn them face-down, mix up the symbols, and take turns trying to match symbols.


